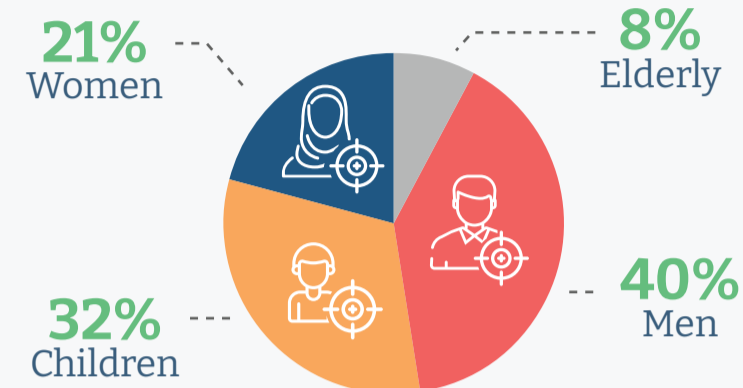

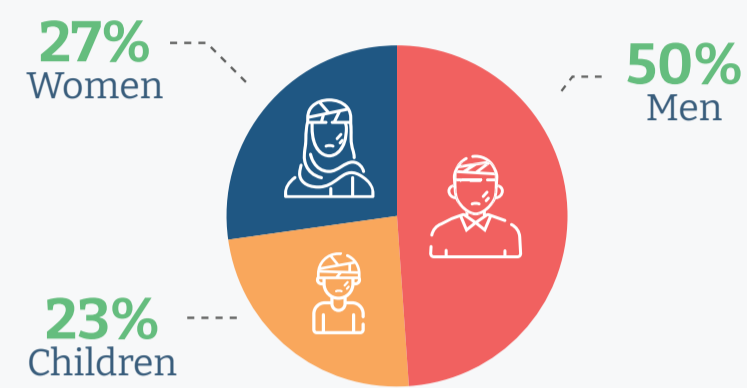

Food insecurity and malnutrition

- 28** Patients Reportedly died of malnutrition
- 1.1 million people experiencing catastrophic food insecurity IPC Phase 5
- 31% of children 6-23 months old in north Gaza are malnourished

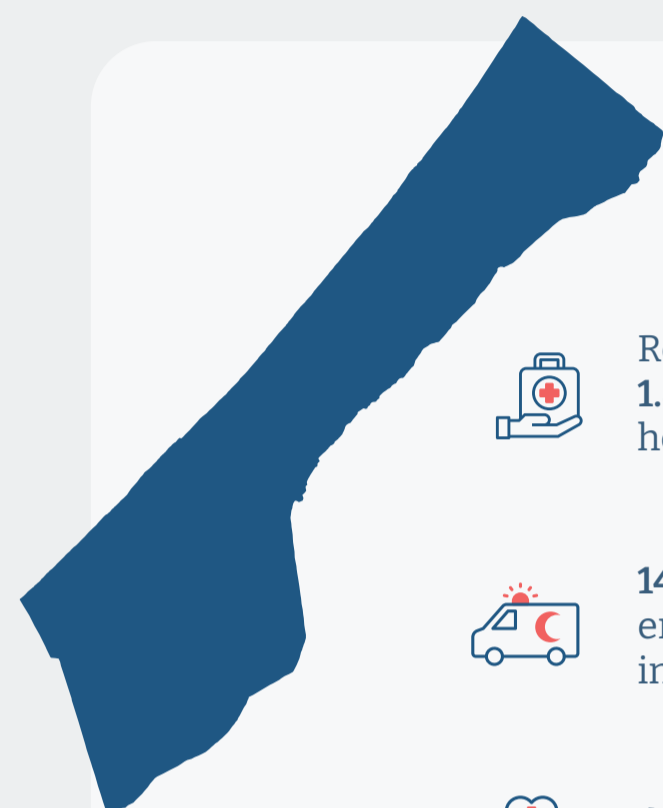
40 Communities in West Bank have no access to primary health care

 Reached an estimated **1.8M** people with various health services




 Checkpoint closures and movement restrictions

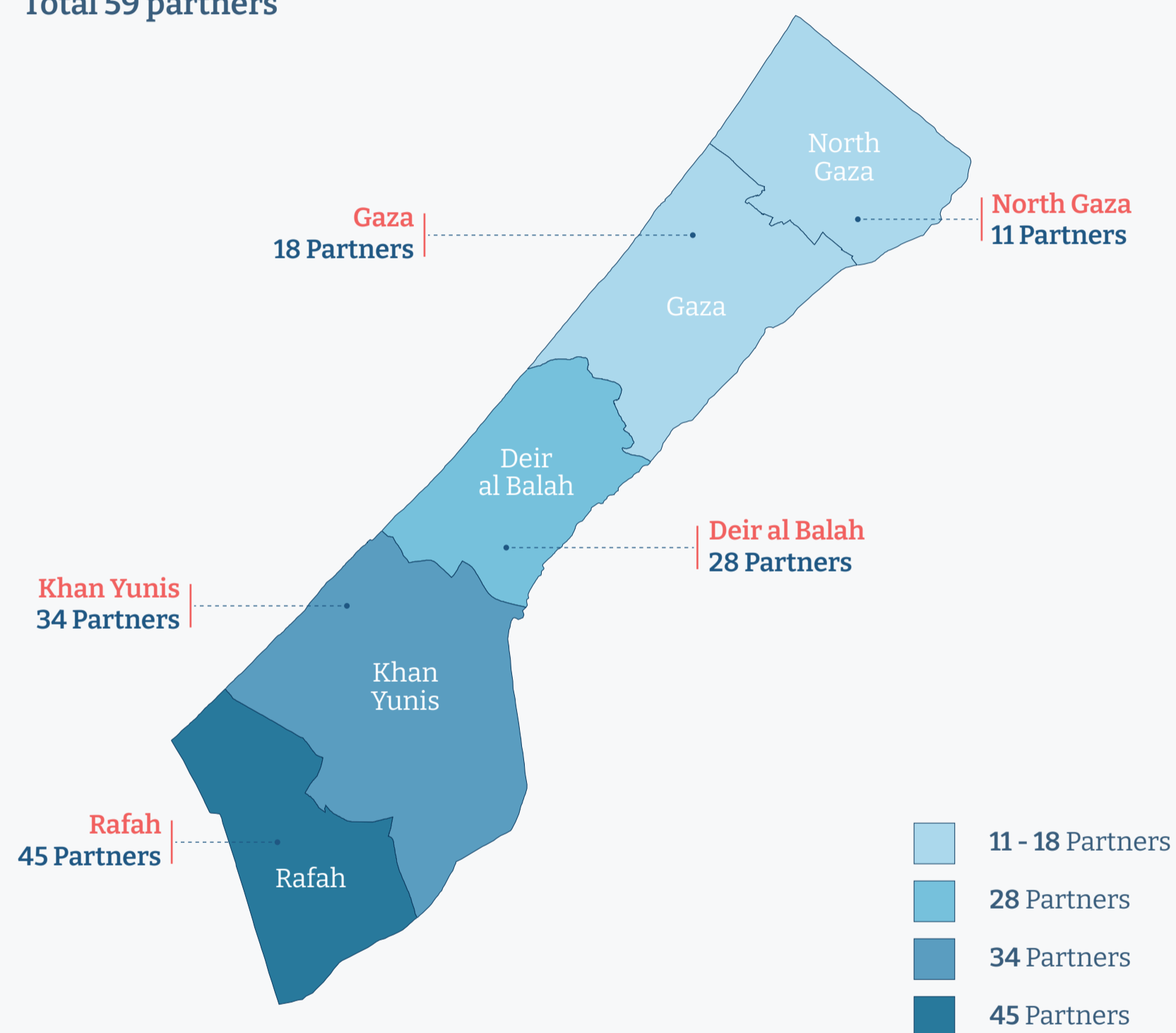

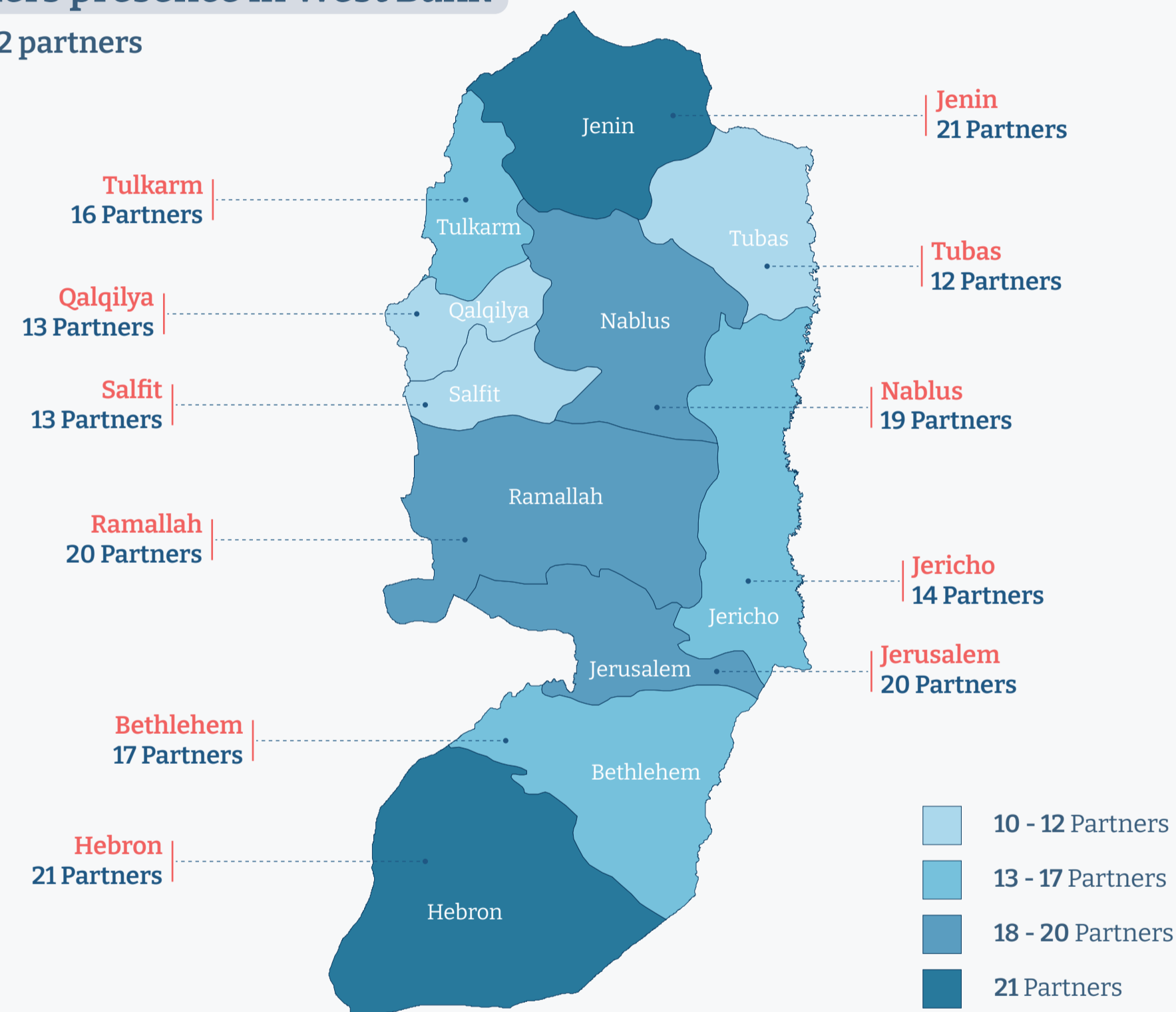
Partners presence in Gaza Strip
