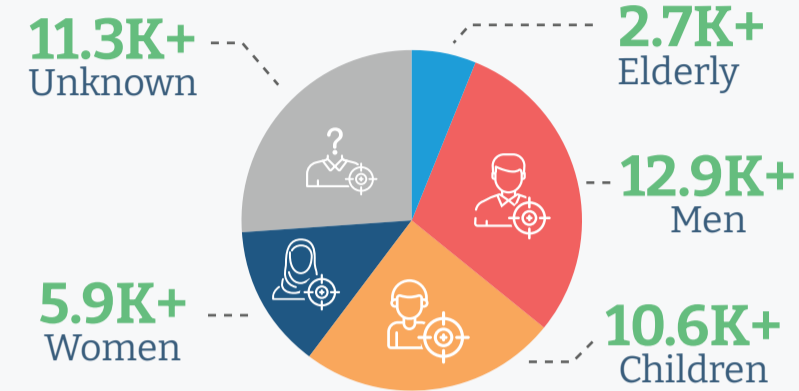

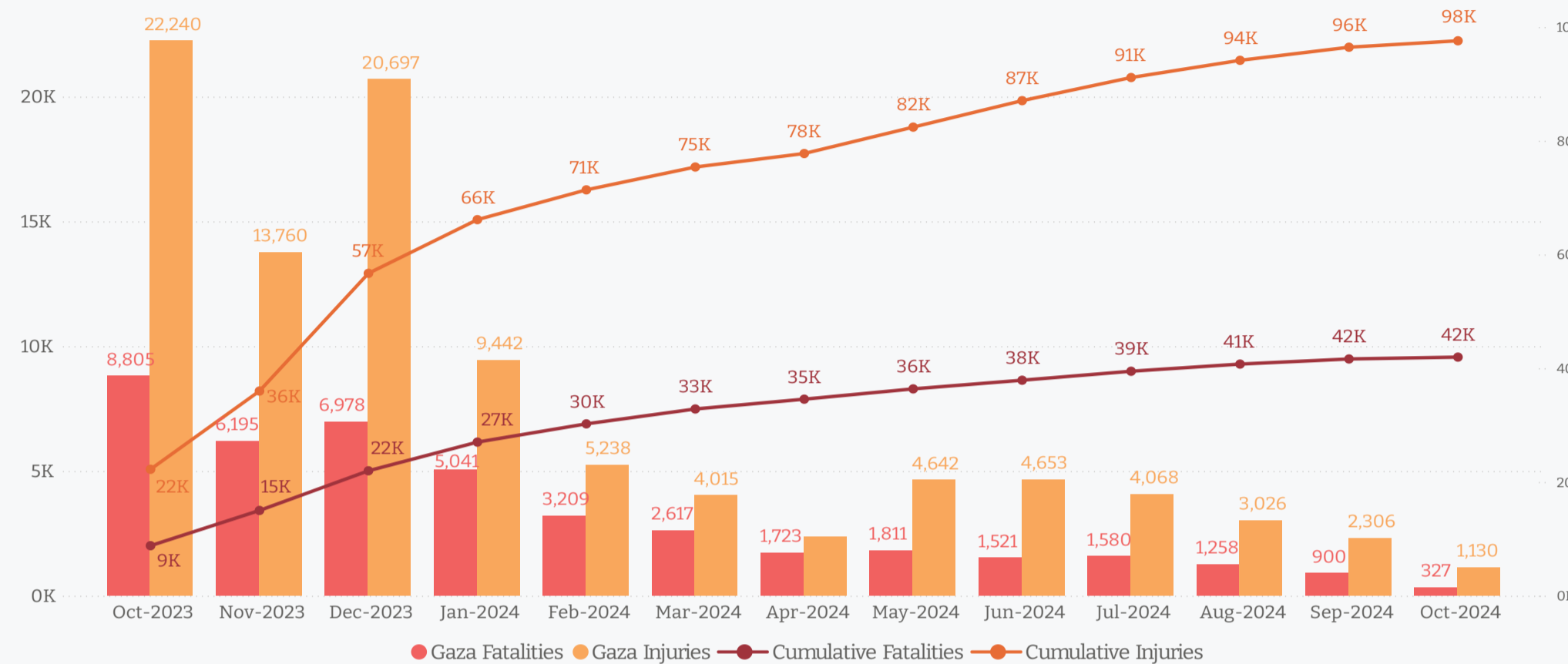

Fatalities and Injuries Trends



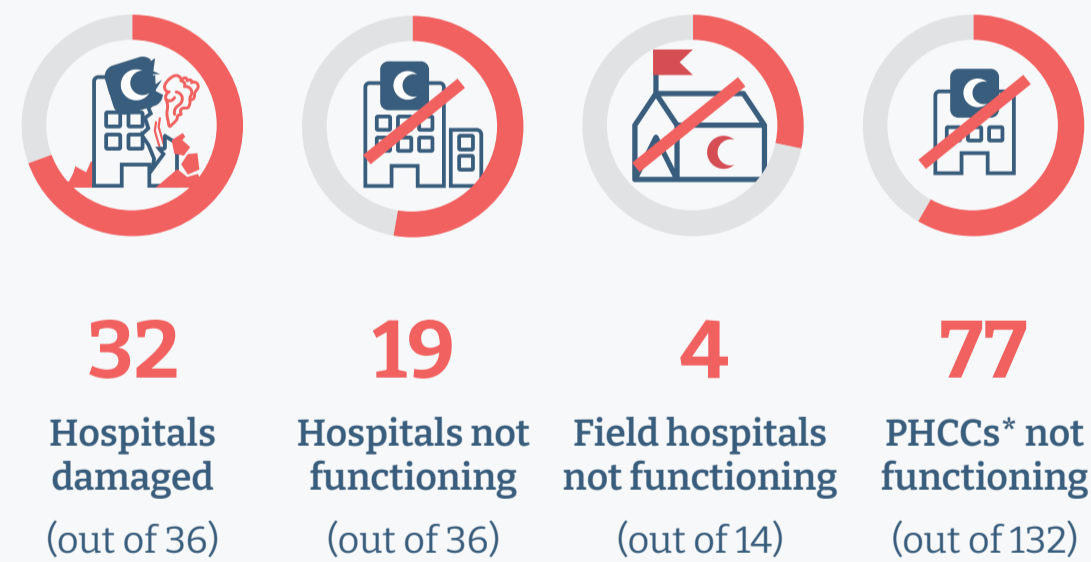
1.9M people displaced (90% of population)

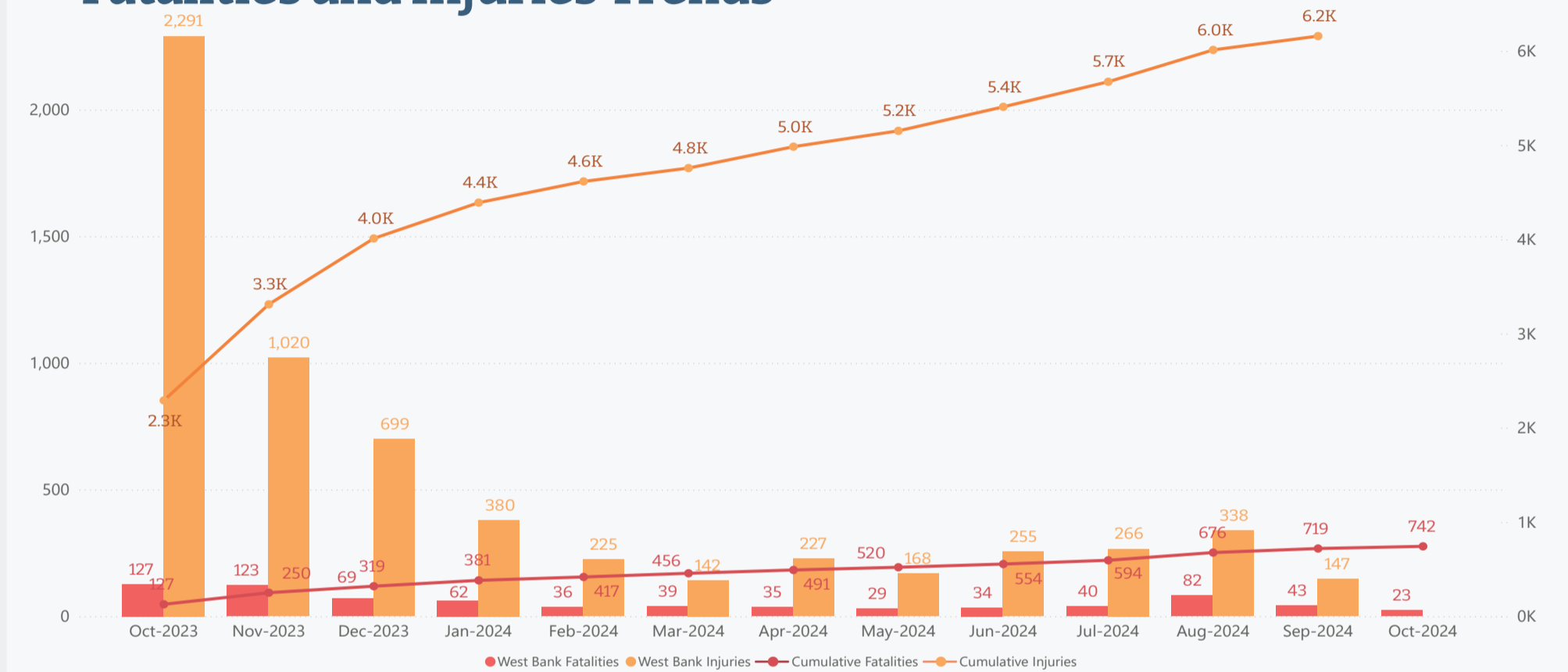

476K+ Trauma-related consultations



9M+ Primary health care consultations



14 (at least two in the northern governorates) Emergency Medical Teams (EMTs) deployed weekly (on average) to support the health response



1.4M+ People provided with basic mental health and psychosocial support



559K+ Children vaccinated in the first round of the polio vaccination campaign

Operational Challenges



High insecurity



Limited access in the north with missions frequently delayed or denied



300+ Humanitarian workers killed; **980+** health workers killed



Repeated mass displacements



Collapse of the formal market and lack of cash



Limited patient evacuation outside Gaza



No/ limited access to electricity and power generation supplies

Gaza Strip



Shortage of medical supplies and equipment



Social stresses affecting capacity of staff to work



Poor telecommunications



Lack of access to basic amenities including food, WASH, shelter



Significant logistical challenges e.g. entry restrictions, etc.



Increased risk of exposure to cold and flooding, as winter approaches



Checkpoint closures and movement restrictions



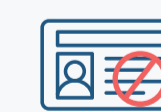
Increased military operations and settler violence



Obstructed access for ambulances, health care workers, and patients



Community displacements



Permits and visas are not being renewed



MoH fiscal crisis and the socio-economic crisis in the population are affecting access to health services

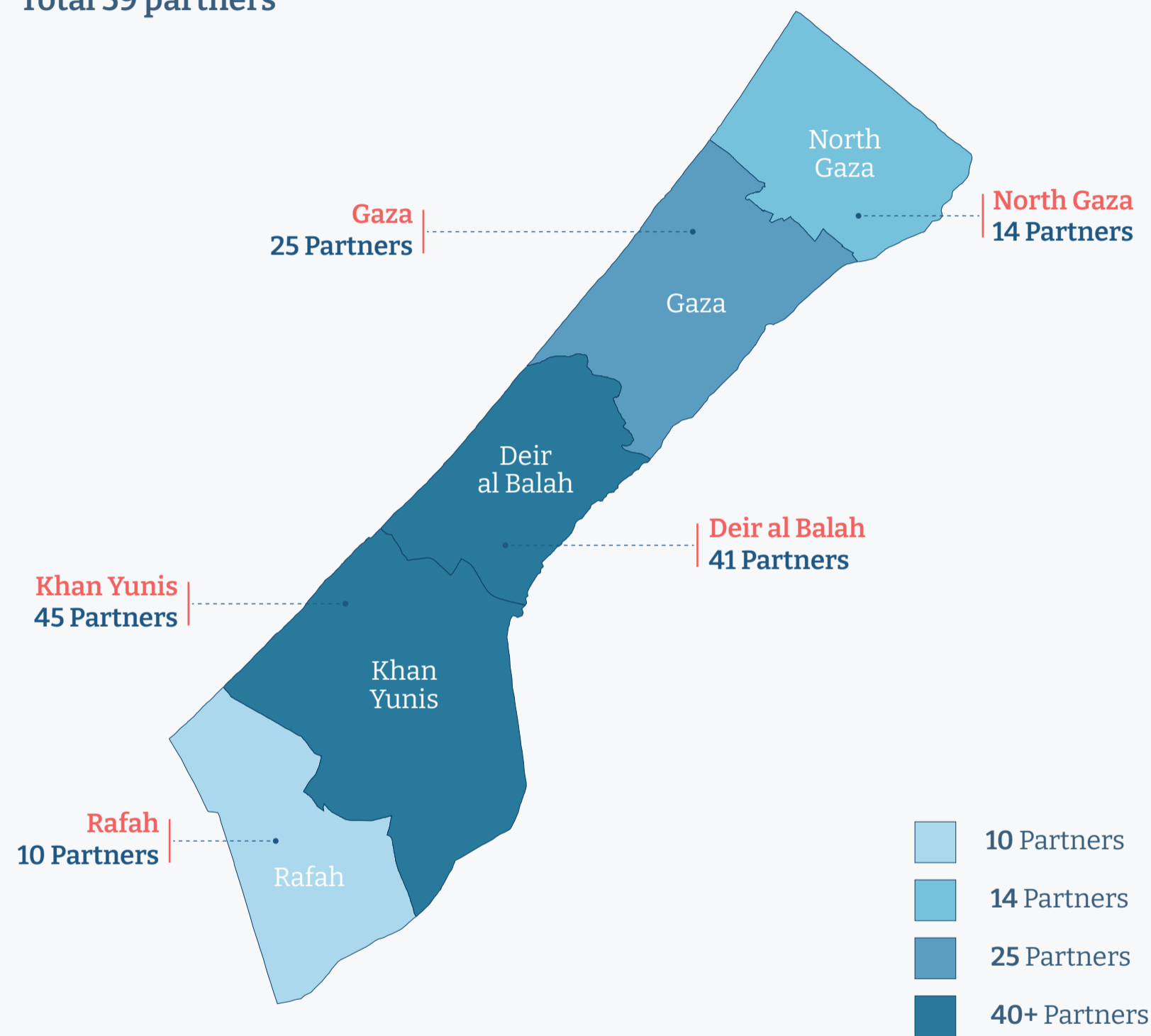

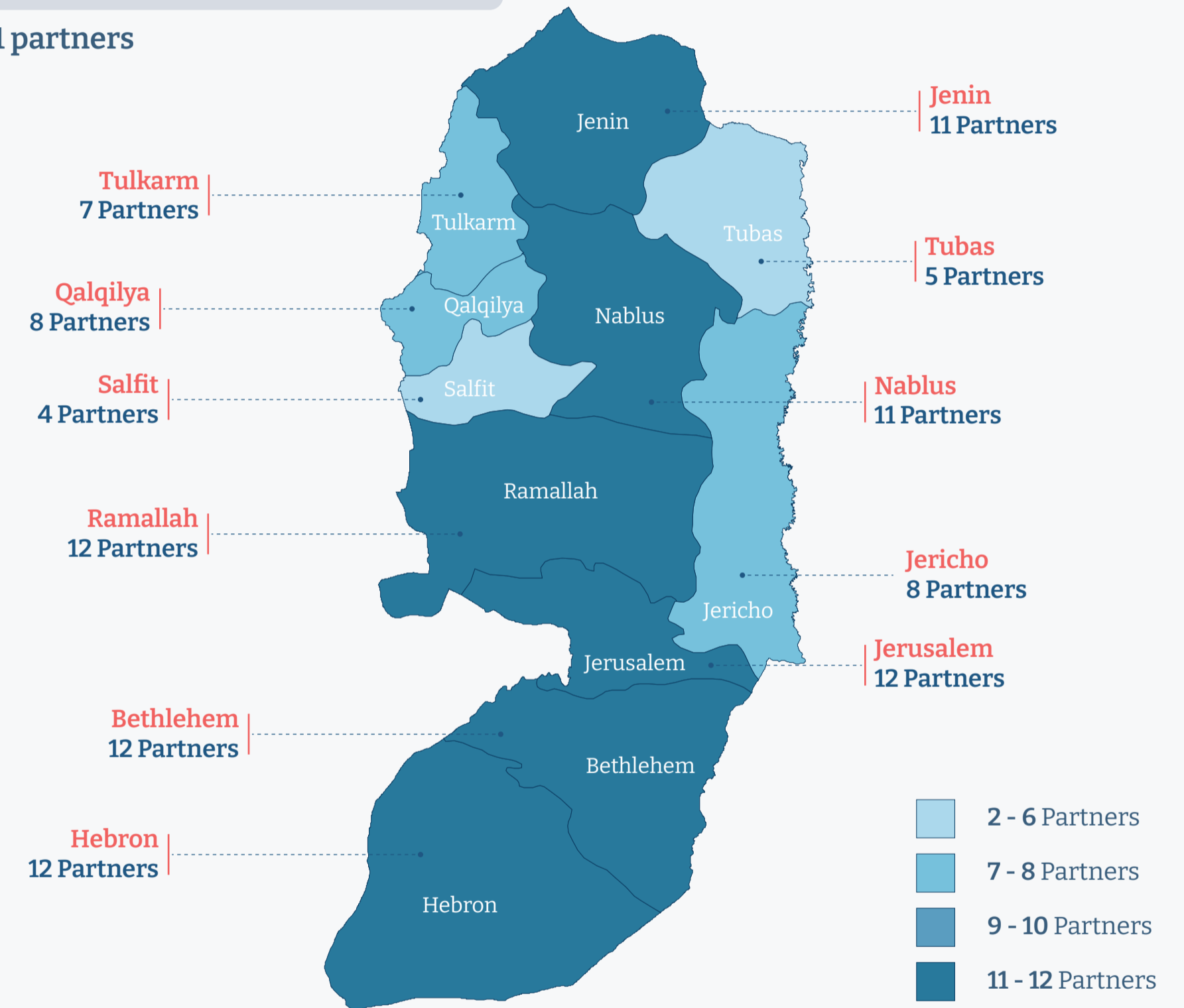
Partners Presence in Gaza Strip

Partners Presence in West Bank

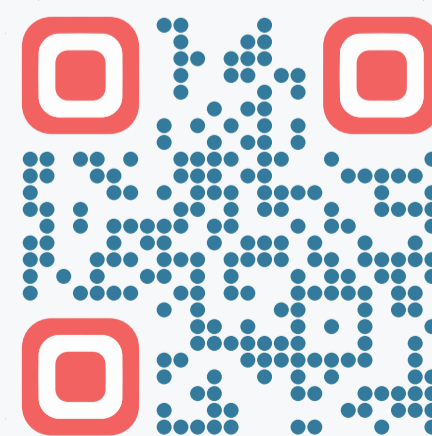
