NORTH GAZA GOVERNORATE

North Gaza Branch & EMS center endured significant destruction. They moved their operations to a temporary location inside Jabalia refugee camp.

- Advanced Medical Post is operational since 20/11/2023.
- 2 ambulances are operational

GAZA GOVERNORATE

Gaza Branch, EMS center & Al Quds Hospital are still not operational since 14/11/2023.

CENTRAL GOVERNORATE

- EMS & relief teams are operational 24/7.
- PHC services are provided.
- 30 displaced families are hosted at the branch.
- 1 IDPs camp host 51 families.
- 2 Medical points

Khan Younis Governorate

- Following the killing of Ameer Abu Aisheh, PRCS staff, while on duty inside PRCS hospital on 24/3/2024, Israeli occupation forces re-imposed siege around the vicinity of Al Amal Hospital.
- Targeting the hospital resumed by occupation forces and led to the death of one of the IDPs and the injury of a PRCS staff.
- Targeting the hospital with smoke bombs and fires led to more damages in different sections in the hospital.
- injured, patients and IDPs were forced to leave towards Al Mawasi.
- In the afternoon of 24/3/2024, medical teams were forced to leave the hospital in PRCS vehicles but they encountered difficulties due to rubble and destroyed roads. They had to return back to the hospital where they found the main gates closed by occupation forces.
- All (31 staff) and two bodies waited in the street in front of the closed gates for 30 hours.
- In the afternoon of 25/3, the OCHA & ICRC managed to get coordination for the convoy to be evacuated to a safer place.

Al Amal Hospital is now out of service.

RAFAH GOVERNORATE

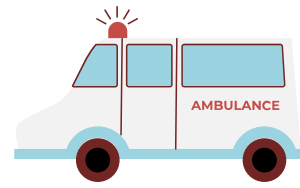
- EMS & relief teams are operational 24/7.
- Al Quds medical post is operational since the start of February 2024.
- Medical services through 3 medical points distributed on various locations in the governorate.
- 3 IDPs camps host 196 families.
- Aid consignments are received, processed & distributed

- Emergency Medical Services (EMS)

- Psycho social support



17,774 injured persons received first aid services & **6,037** fatalities were evacuated by PRCS teams.



162,298 individuals benefiting from community health services & health awareness activities.



58,399 individuals benefiting from psycho social support activities.

These services are being offered across the displacement camps established by PRCS, at their medical posts, as well as in shelters managed by UNRWA.

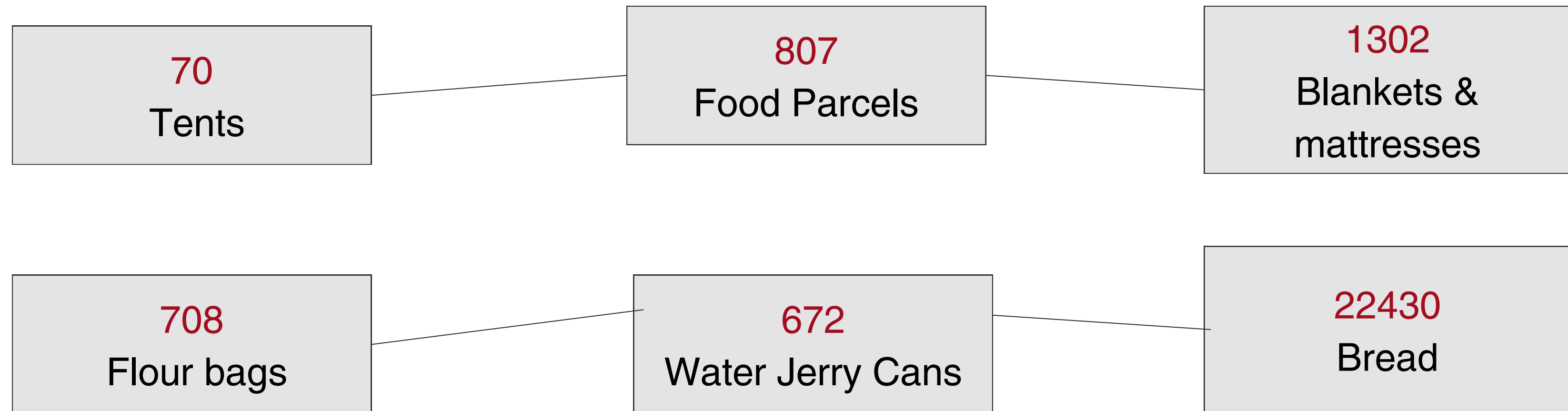

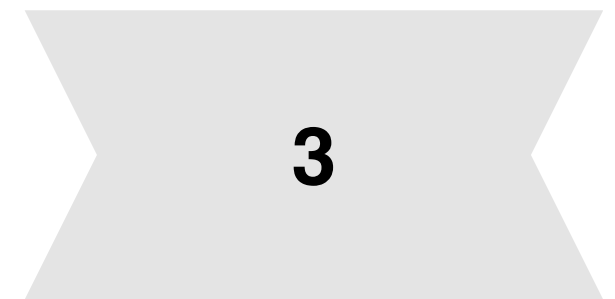
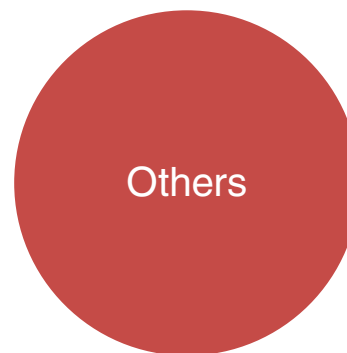

PRCS lost another staff member in Gaza Strip. Ameer Abu Aisheh (23 yrs old) was killed by Israeli occupation while on duty inside PRCS Al Amal Hospital on early morning of 24/3/2024.

Abu Aisheh was one of the operations room staff member and media coordinator.



The deliberate targeting of PRCs's medical mission represents a grave infringement of International Humanitarian Law, (IHL) notably violating the Geneva Conventions

Emergency Appeal:

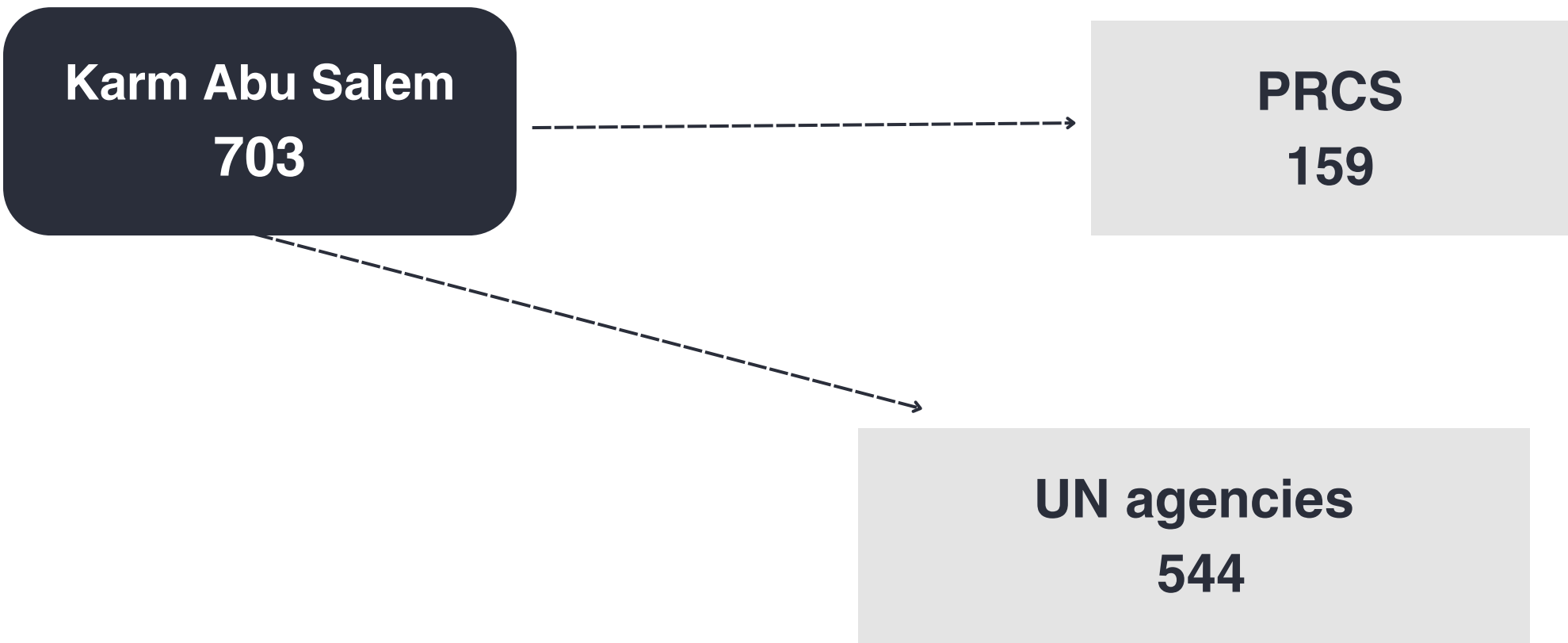
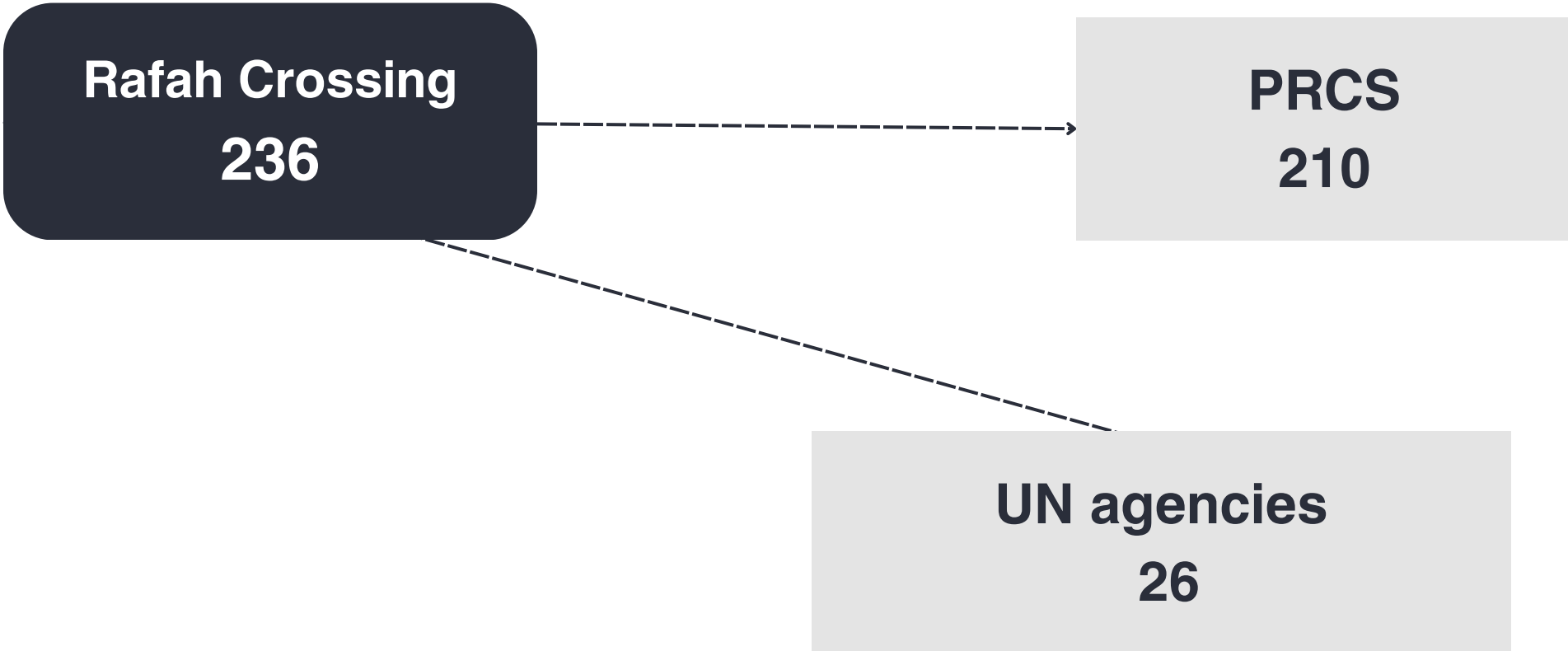

- As of 10\3\2024, contributions from a variety of national societies, international organizations, and the private sector **have fulfilled 20% of the requested cash funds.**

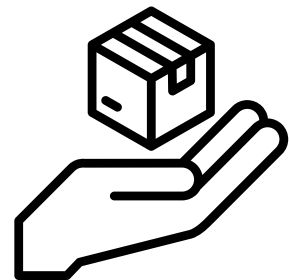
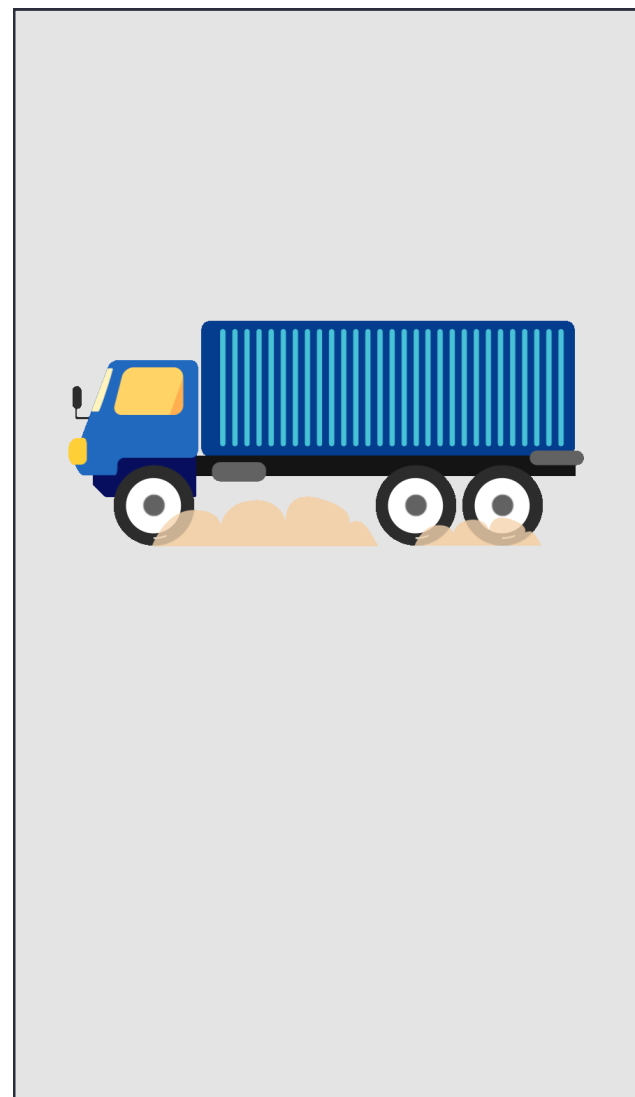

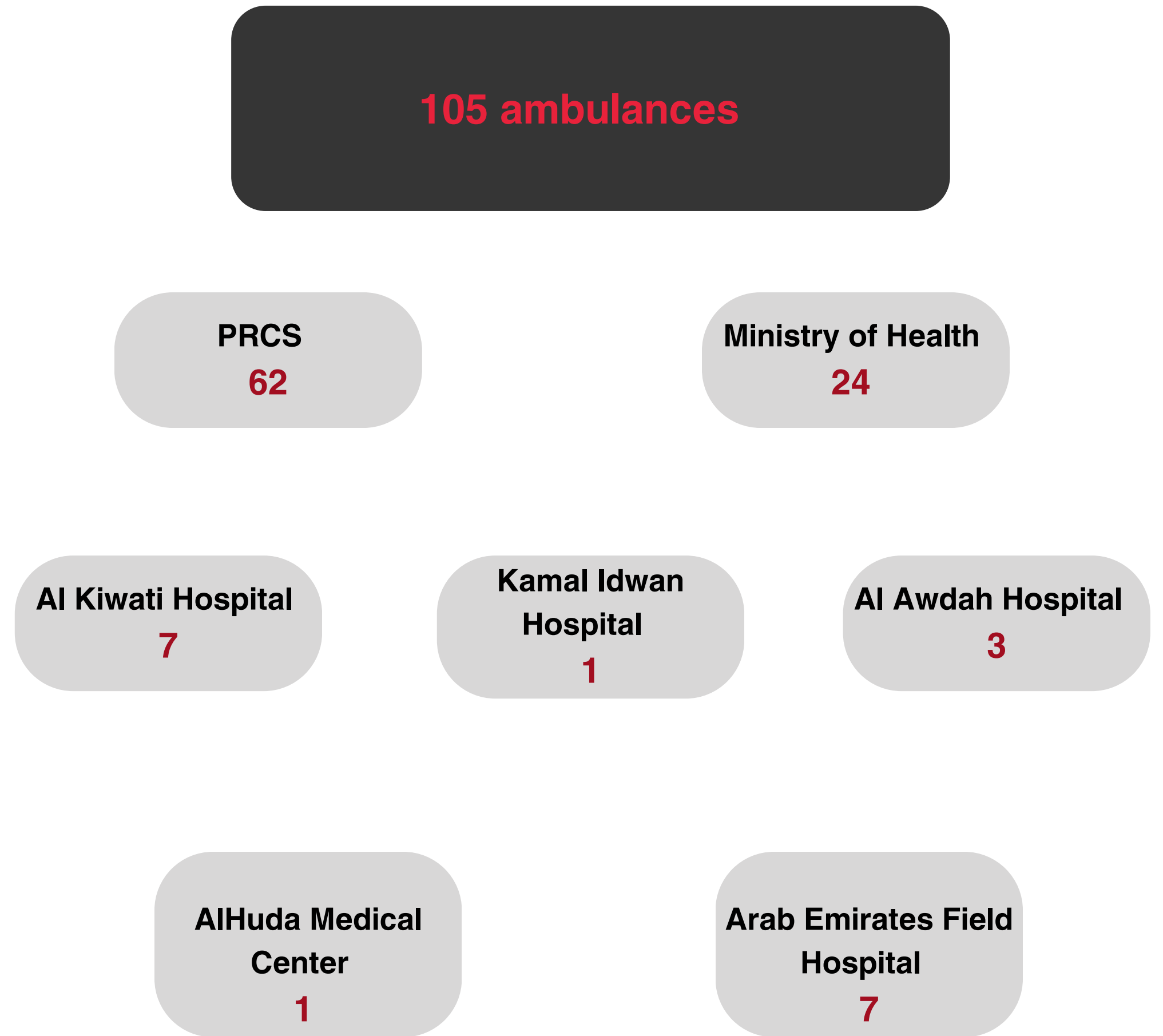
